

BEARFOOT RIDER INFORMATION:

- **IMPORTANT- ALL RIDERS MUST HAVE THE FOLLOWING:** No exception, no excuses.
- Street legal, green or "red" sticker registration, spark arrester/muffler are a requirement and will be checked at Tech. USFS will be checking sound (96db. or less) at Tech.
- The Forest Service WILL ALLOW non-registered 2022 Model Year and newer competition motorcycles to enter and compete in the EVENT ONLY. There will be strict enforcement that no practice riding pre-or post-event. Any non compliance will impact allowance for future events and can result in disqualification of rider from this event.
- **KEY TIME:** 9:00am. Follow all signs that are posted to direct riders to Start Area.
- **GAS:** There is no remote Gas. Gas will be back at your truck/rig. Please use DOT approved gas cans.
- **COURSE:** Check course markings at the trailer for information on loop colors and symbols.
- ***Caution*** - All effort was made to clear trees along course, but some can still fall and exist on trails. Please be aware of hazards along the trails and ride at your own ability.
- RRMCM will sweep the course, so stay with your bike if in need of assistance.
- **SCORING:** Fender cards must be turned into the trailer immediately at the end of the race. Please turn cards in, even if you don't finish.
- **Same day trophies will be handed out**, please come check results at the trailer before leaving the race.

FORESTRY RULES:

- RRMCM has a special use permit for this event. Violations of Forest Service Rules jeopardizes future events.
- No parking on main roads. Park in designated areas only or vehicles will be cited by the Forest Service. There is ample parking and restrooms at Davis Flat area.
- Campfire permits are required. Please put all fires out, and remove trash to proper areas. • **WARNING:** SPEED LIMIT is 15 mph in campground areas.
- While on motorcycles be sure to use access trail between Davis Flat and main road, law enforcement expected.
- Use bike routes to and from camp sites. Do not ride on County Roads.
- Riders are responsible for family and friends.
