TO ALL CLUBS AND PROMOTERS

The purpose of this meeting is to award dates for the upcoming 2025 District 36 competition season and to elect District 36 Board of Directors for 2025. This meeting is mandatory for all Active Members (Club Officers, Promoters and Referees) and Competition Committeemen (ref: Operations Manual section 1.2.1). It is also mandatory for all District 36 Chartered Clubs and /or Promoters wanting sanction dates for the upcoming year (ref: Operations Manual section 1.3). To be awarded a date(s) for your 2024 meet(s) you must be Chartered for 2025. The Charter fee is \$50.00 if done on or before the Sanction Meeting and \$100.00 if done after the meeting.

It is also strongly recommended that you review page 6-7, section 1.5 “Sanctioning” in the current District 36 Operations manual.

Attached is the 2025 District 36 Charter Application. To save time at the meeting, please go to the D36 Website and apply **prior to the Sanction Meeting** with your current Club Officers. If you have already completed the 2025 online charter application, then you will not need to fill out the form at the meeting. And of course, this form will also be available at the meeting. And a special thank you to those clubs and promoters who have already completed their online Charter Application.

If you have not already completed the 2025 online charter application, please be prepared to pay the application fee at the meeting. If you do not bring payment to the meeting and/or have not completed the online form with payment, then you will not be allowed to receive meet dates with District 36 for the 2025 season. If Chartering after the Sanction Meeting there is a late fee.

Please Note: If your club holds elections after September 18, 2021 please complete the application with your current officer’s information. After your elections, you must send in another application with your 2025 club officer’s information updated.

Race Season:

The race season for District 36 runs from December 1 through November 30 each year. In Cross Country racing the season is split into the Spring and Fall for the B & C Riders (two separate series). There may be a 2024 race run in December as a makeup date but this is rare.
