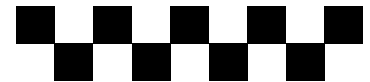

D36 Enduro Steward's Report

It has been a busy spring season for the enduro series with all rounds enjoying good weather except the snow at the Wildhorse on Sunday. The Sawmill and Crosscut enduros returned after several valiant attempts by North Bay MC over the past couple of years. It was a great event with the club not showing any rust from the years off. JT Baker won the adult overall and Zach McKay the family enduro overall.

Next up was the two day Wilseyville enduros, Lane Lorenzo took the overall both days and JT Baker took the money in the Pro class both days. At the 49er enduros' Sutton Mills claimed the overall at the family enduro for the second year in a row and JT Baker was back on the top of the box for the win at the adult Enduro. Rounding out the series before the summer break, at the Fools Gold, Ryder Thomaselli brought his ISDE Husky 125 down from Nevada to win the event overall.

As the enduro series heads in the summer break JT Baker has a firm hold on first place in the Overall standings. Veteran Mason Willets leads all "B" class riders and Leo McDonell is the top rider in the "C" division. In the Family enduro series Zach McKay holds the lead in that series with his father Jordan in second place.

The Other Side Of The Fence



We all love to ride motorcycles and most of us have found that competing makes the riding experience much more enjoyable. Although your non-riding friends and family say you're crazy, the fact is you are normal in that competition is in all of us whether it be on the race-track, in the business world or life in general. We all compete throughout life and for most it's not a matter of beating the other guy but a matter of proving to ourselves that we stand up to the test. While we can't win every race, we leave the track knowing we gave it our best and that's what it's all about.

There's another aspect of competition that a large percentage of riders don't get to experience and that is "standing on the other side of the fence". Here, having volunteered to "work" instead of race, you feel a sense of pride in helping to make the race a success.

I'm talking about being a part of a special group of individuals that put on the races we competitors so much enjoy participating in. You may be the one standing there with the green flag or checkered flag in hand, or the guy or gal on a corner with a yellow flag, possibly the one spending a few hours in the forest at a check

scoring each rider that passes through, maybe out hanging arrows to mark a course, riding sweep to make sure racers get help if needed, or....., well the list goes on and on. It takes a lot of very dedicated individuals to make any type of meet a success. Without them, you the competitor, would not get the quality events put on by our local clubs and promoters that we have all come to expect in District 36 sanctioned events.

Helping to put on an event also gives one a much different point of view. You get to see the whole process and not just the race itself. You can ask any rider that "works" an event and they will tell you that by seeing things for this angle it has made them a better "racer" overall.

The clubs and promoters that put on these events do need all the help they can get so join a club or volunteer to help at a race. You can still get points to stay in the hunt for that year-end award, all the while experience racing from a whole different perspective.

What Is The District 36 LAO And It's Benefits To You

In 1988 District 36 created the District 36 Legislative Action Office (LAO). This is a full-time program that's only purpose is to monitor, protect and work against closures, unreasonable laws and State/Federal regulations that harm legal OHV recreation. This office was created to address the issue of one riding area after another being closed or greatly reduced in size, affecting our events and trail riding opportunities on both public as well as private lands.



When riding areas close or are unfairly restricted, it not only affects our clubs and promoters that put on events, but it also affects YOU, the weekend rider, as you lose places to ride. You may or may not be aware of the constant barrage of anti-OHV groups that want to take away your access to public and even private lands for legal motorized recreation. If you are aware, you already understand that we must stand together. If you are not, then you may be in for a rude awakening when, some day you go to your favorite riding area only to find a locked gate.

To continue to fight for you we need revenue from memberships, but just as important, we need volunteers to be organized and keep an eye on their favorite riding areas, reporting back to our LAO office and holding public official's feet to the fire to protect our Right to Ride. These efforts create clout and credibility for our sport. The more members we have the louder our voice when dealing with elected and appointed officials who make decisions about how and where we ride.

How can you help? First, you can join District 36. It's forty dollars per year. That is the simplest way to get involved (and maybe good karma on the trail). Second, get involved at any level you choose. Usually there is a riding area you frequent and you may have some suggestions about making it better, or maybe your riding area is threatened. Either way, we suggest you contact our LAO office and volunteer to help. Just you being able to go to local meetings and give us a heads up would be a tremendous help and our LAO officer will help you get started.

In the end you may be responsible in part for saving or improving your favorite riding area for generations of riders who follow you, including your kids and their kids. It's a good feeling to go riding while carrying the pride of protecting a place you think is special. Thank you for caring and let's work together to sustain a sport we all think so much of. 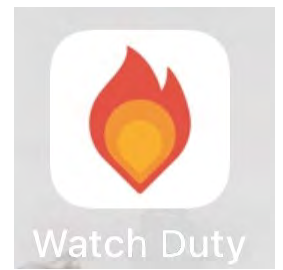

A MESSAGE FROM DON AMADOR

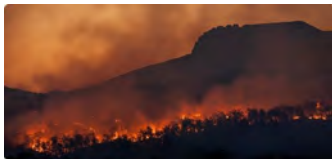

We also know just how important it is for us to have access to a rapid and accurate alert system when a fire starts nearby that could threaten our homes and family and use that information to take the appropriate action.

Over the years, access to that rapid and accurate wildfire information has been spotty at best. Fortunately, the WATCH DUTY app was created in 2021 by a team of tech savvy and deeply committed first responders, fire professionals, and seasoned communication experts.

WATCH DUTY states their mission is to publish only the facts that provide true situational awareness in case of emergency, without editorialization or prediction. We honor integrity and correctness over speed or sensationalism so we can build and maintain trust with not only our community but our first responders.

WATCH DUTY is a free app that I downloaded in 2022 when I joined the emergency wildfire response effort in Northern California by driving wildfire suppression supplies from the North Zone Fire Cache located at the Redding Airport to fire camps throughout the region. It keeps me updated on fires that I am driving on and if there is a new fire start or a fire start near my home or that of a friend. My wife got the WATCH DUTY app so she could keep track of her family and friends as well.

Have A Rule You Think Needs To Be Added Or Changed?

The District 36 Operations Manual is a rulebook covering District 36 Procedures and Competition. Procedural rules are decided on by the District 36 Board of Directors and rules governing Competition are decided on by the District 36 Active Members (Clubs and Promoters).

Do you, as a current member of District 36, have a rule proposal you want to get submitted? If so you will need to fill out a Rule Proposal Form and submit it to the appropriate steward....CC rules to the CC Steward; Jeremy Carlin, Enduro Rules to the Enduro Steward; Bruce Hendrickson, and Dirt Track Rules to the Dirt Track Steward; Mike Fowler. If your proposal is not discipline specific or applies to all disciplines you will submit your proposal to the Rules Chairman, [Bill McGibbon](#) and the Director of Competition, [Brian Garrahan](#).

We have rules for Rule Proposals and it's recommended

Rules submitted and approved take effect the following year

that if you're submitting a proposal you review the current [District 36 Operations Manual](#), section 1.6 Rulebook

The Rule Proposal form is editable (Download it first then you can fill it out on your computer and “save as”) or print them and fill them out by hand. To submit your proposal:

- Submitter must be a current District 36 Member.
- Fill out a [Rule Proposal / Change Form](#) completely.
- Submit the proposal by one of the following :
 - ◇ Send the proposal electronically to the appropriate person. You will find a list of steward contacts on our [District 36 Contact Page](#).
 - ◇ Hand it to a Steward at a meet.
 - ◇ Hand it in at a monthly D36 Meeting
 - ◇ Mail it to District 36 (see contact page)
