District 36 Speedway & Flat Speed Rules

Regarding bike specifications & rules refer to AMA Handbook for Speedway and District 36 dirt track (short track) bikes specs and rules.

On Track Race Heat & Main Rules

- 1) All riders when lining up at start tapes will be positioned equally in start boxes with the same distance (front wheel to tape) Approx. 6 inches from tape.
- 2) 1st rider touching the tapes after being positioned is the same as rolling in dirt track. Automatic penalty line infraction.
- 3) Breaking the tapes will also result in penalty line infraction.
- 4) Laps- All Speedway Heats, Semi's, Consolation & Mains are 4 laps. In Flat Speed all Heats, Semi's, Consolation are 6 laps, all Mains are 8 laps. The exception would be youth classes. All youth races including mains are 4 laps.
- 5) If two or more riders tie on points for the championship a runoff will decide the winner.

1st 8, 2nd 7, 3rd 6, 4th 5, 5th 4, 6th 3, 7th 2, 8th 1, Consolation 1st 1 point
