

## District 36 Dirt Track Supplemental Rules

### NUMBER PLATES

- Three (3) number plates for all Short Track, TT and Scrambles events must be secured to the front and both sides of all machines entered and display the rider's current D-36 number & letter. All plates are to be plainly visible.

Exceptions: Current AFT licensed riders can display their current AFT number and color when racing in a District 36 race. D36-recognized class champions may elect to run their current class championship plates in the class awarded only, or any non-championship class- for example the Open A BP1 may not ride in the Vintage class, or any other class (except any "Money" classes) using said BP1 plate. New D36 members may display an "X", "O" or similar temporary number until they receive their assigned D36 number. Penalty for violating this rule- rider may be penalized 1 lap.

Number plates shall correspond to the rider's classification. The mandatory sizes and color schemes for D-36 dirt track events can be found in the D36 Operations Manual sections 6.14 to 6.17 .2. At the Dirt Track Steward's discretion, Pee Wee riders may drop the first digit of any 3-digit number from their plate if doing so will improve visibility.
